The mission of the Santa Rosa Symphony (SRS) education department is to continue to transmit the profound legacy of classical music. Today the SRS is widely recognized for one of the most comprehensive music education programs in California.

The SRS features four youth ensembles:

The Preparatory Orchestra is a full orchestra for beginning students between ages 7 and 13. Founded in 1977, the primary focus of the Preparatory Orchestra is to provide a rich and rewarding experience for musicians who have played their instruments for at least 2 years.

The **Discovery Orchestra** is a full orchestra for intermediate to advanced students. Established in 1994, the Discovery Orchestra is for students up to 18 years of age.

The **Young People's Chamber Orchestra** is a small chamber ensemble that takes traditional orchestra performance one step further and molds the students into a virtuoso, conductorless ensemble. The YPCO has participated in the Junior Bach Festival.

The **Youth Orchestra** was founded in 1959. Youth Orchestra musicians must be committed to a rigorous routine of rehearsals, private lessons, at-home practice and performances. Music performed is from the standard symphonic orchestral repertoire. In 2002, the Youth Orchestra performed in Carnegie Hall. To celebrate their 50th Anniversary, the Youth Orchestra traveled to Prague, Leipzig and Berlin in June, 2009.

- Our ensembles present 11 concerts per year, including a Concerto Competition to feature gifted soloists.
- The Discovery Orchestra and Youth Orchestra present Free Concerts for Youth for local school children serving over 6,000 public school children.
- We have 156 musicians from 126 families. Our musicians come from all over Sonoma County as well as Novato, Napa, Angwin and Ukiah. Our youngest musician is 7 and our oldest musician is 23.
- We give away nearly \$3,000 in financial aid each year to enable under-privileged students to participate in the ensembles.
- We honor our young leaders with scholarships for private lessons.
