Santa Rosa Symphony Seeks Volunteer Ushers

(SANTA ROSA, CA) – The Santa Rosa Symphony seeks volunteer ushers for the upcoming season which runs from October 9-11, 2010 through May 7-9, 2011. The Symphony asks that volunteers commit to seven concerts throughout the Classical Series season by choosing from the following times: Saturday evenings at 8 p.m., Saturday afternoons at 2 p.m., Sunday afternoons at 3 p.m. or Monday evenings at 8 p.m. Reporting times for ushers is 1-1/2 hours before the concert start time. Performances are at the Wells Fargo Center for the Arts, 50 Mark West Springs Road in Santa Rosa.

The Symphony also needs ushers for special programs such as the holiday choral concerts on December 9 (Windsor); December 10 (Petaluma); and December 11 (Santa Rosa). Substitute ushers are needed for all performances.

A 2-hour training session is **REQUIRED** for all ushers. There are two times to choose from: Saturday, September 11 or Saturday, September 25 at noon at the Wells Fargo Center for the Arts.
